





Hang Out Together


During their internship, the NTU students and their Vietnamese colleagues formed lasting memories, enjoying picnics and embarking on adventures to explore nearby attractions.

At Global Ready Talent, we understand the unique challenges that Singaporean students face when venturing abroad to work, such as in Vietnam, for a ten-week period.




